

## Visiting rules in connection with Coronavirus / Covid-19

For personal appointments at **other departments of Kreisverwaltung (District Administration) reservations must be made by phone**. Especially in case of urgent personal consultation that cannot be postponed, advance booking by phone is required.

**As of 22 April 2021, Oberberg District exercises its domestic authority ordering visitors to wear a face mask for appointments with its [departments](#):**

### **Requirement to wear a face mask**

Visitors are requested to wear a medical grade face mask when entering District Administration offices.

#### **Medical grade face masks:**

- FFP2 mask (without a valve)
- FFP3 mask (without a valve)
- Surgical mask

**Exceptions:** If children under the age of 14 cannot wear a medical grade face mask or respirator due to incorrect fit, a face covering must be worn as an alternative. Children up to the school entrance age and individuals who cannot wear a mask for medical reasons are exempt from the obligation to wear a mask. Such medical reasons must be confirmed by a medical certificate to be presented upon request.
